Quorum: A quorum of 25% of BWRMA members, in good standing in our community, was obtained with 4 Board members in attendance and 16 completed Proxy Ballots. The list of Proxy forms received will be posted to our website along with these minutes: bwrma.org.

1. CALL TO ORDER 6:35pm

2. APPROVAL OF 2021 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES:

BWRMA minutes are posted on line at http://bwrma.org and emailed to BWRMA property owners.

Bill Richey moved and Jim McGillis seconded the motion to approve the Draft 2021 Annual Meeting Minutes as posted on the BWRMA website. The motion carried unanimously. The Approved 2021 Annual Meeting Minutes will be posted on the BWRMA website.

3. APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT:

- Balances: Ralph reported total balance of \$70,152.04 in checking and savings as of February 20, 2022. Expected receipt of income in last year's budget was \$26,499.90 (estimated from historical records.). Actual income received was \$19,899.21, which was much lower than expected. The lower income receipts were discussed at great length during the meeting.
- **Budget:** Ralph reported that during the COVID-19 pandemic, BWRMA proposed work in the amount of \$41,500. However, the actual amount expended was \$11,354.10—resulting in a balance of \$30,145.90.
- Ralph identified completed work in Fiscal Year 2021-2022, noting the difficulty in getting contractors to provide bids for work during the pandemic. He then reviewed the planned scope of work for all roads in the Proposed 2022-2023 Budget.

Discussion followed regarding budget issues.

Wayne Richie moved and Jim McGillis seconded to adjust the proposed amount of \$3,000 to the previously allocated amount of \$4,000 be transferred to the paving replacement fund. The motion carried unanimously.

Jim McGillis moved and Ralph Santamaria seconded a motion to adopt the Proposed 2022-2023, Fiscal Year Budget, as amended above. The motion carried unanimously.

2022-2023 BWRMA Adopted Budget.

Melanie Maibaum moved and Ralph Santamaria seconded a motion that a separate letter be sent to non-paying residents for maintaining our roads. The motion carried unanimously.

• **2021-2022 Annual Audit**—The annual audit, for the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year, was conducted by Barbara Zinkil on March 31,2022. She examined and approved Tom's copies of checks received/paid and journal entries. Barbara was thanked for her efforts. It was noted that the Annual BWRMA Audits are posted on our website: bwrma.org

4. OLD BUSINESS:

• 2021-2022 Road Maintenance Items

Ralph stated the COVID-19 Pandemic limited non-essential work and noted the paved roads were not repaired as planned in Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

Completed maintenance activities were referenced in the recent Annual Meeting Mailing and include:

Roadside brush clearing

Culvert clearing of large branches, stumps and debris

Pot-holes filled and ruts on roadside edges of paved roads filled in

Additional Weed abatement on Hidden Springs

Drain pipe cleared under Bywater Way N road plus additional channel digging

5. NEW BUSINESS:

• Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Planned Work:

Below are the Proposed 2022-2023 Road Maintenance items, for all of our roads, that were included in the recent Annual Meeting Mailing:

- ✓ Asphalt road repairs and overlays
- ✓ Annual roadside brush clearing
- ✓ Repair gravel road ruts and pot holes in dryer weather
- ✓ Weed abatement on Hidden Springs Rd
- ✓ Rut fill along sides of paved roads plus pot hole fills on gravel roads
- ✓ Additional sweeping of asphalt roads towards end of year plus culvert cleaning
- ✓ Repair dip on Hidden Springs Road with asphalt
- ✓ Fill in dip with asphalt on Bywater Way Road near Shipview Court

Discussion followed.

The board plans to complete another road inspection to identify work to be addressed in the bids. Discussion followed regarding some specific areas on Bywater Way N, Hidden Springs and areas drainage pipes were cleared, crossing under the roads.

In all cases, members will be informed about the company selected for asphalt repair in case they want asphalt work done on their own property on the side, as well as notification of traffic disruption on our roads.
